General Instructions

Future developments. For the latest information about developments related to Form W-9 and its instructions, such as legislation enacted after they were published, go to www.irs.gov/FormW9.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- . Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- . Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- . Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- . Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- . Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.

There were a few major changes made for this upcoming season after our teacher Advisory Board meeting. Check Sports You (www.SportsYou.com) when your Charter becomes active to see all the new updates, changes, and NEW and Improved 2023-2024 HSBBQ Competition event rules and guidelines.

HSBBQ EVENT HIGHLIGHT UPDATES:

- All payments will be made to the National High School BBQ Association and a check will be cut to the Host School for their fundraising event. 100% still goes to the HSBBQ Event Host School.
- NEW M.E.A.T Scoring system as part of the Barbecue Report Card Judging Cards.
- The School District Charter covers all Middle School and High School Teams competing and as many teams as you would like under one charter. Five students per team and two alternates.
- 2023-2024 five Regional Food Contest Categories St. Louis Pork Ribs, Whole Chicken (presented as two halves), Grilled Pork Chop, Grilled Skirt Steak Fajita Taco, and Chili. (Students must cook all 5)
- NATIONAL ONLY, 6th Food Contest Category Whole Beef Tri-Tip
- All equipment and trailers MUST FIT in a 20x20 Cook Off area. (Forrest will measure!).
- Each team must have 12 28' inch tall safety cones any color or PVC pipe extended to 28'inches.
- All fire starting equipment must be started and lit from a can of sterno on the ground. NO HOLDING LIGHTERS OR ANY FIRE STARTING DEVICE in a student's or coaches hands.
- NO CUTTING FIRE WOOD AT CONTEST EVENTS. NONE, NOT AT ALL, WILL BE DISQUALIFED
- One student must have a State food handlers or county food safety card. Next School year ALL student teams members must have a food safety card and a copy at each event.
- Next year we will have an exclusive Middle School Division at HSBBQ STATE CONTESTS.
- Any team that goes to a contest and has not paid 8 business days prior to that event will not be able
 to compete. No refunds will be given for cancellations, but payment can be applied to another
 contest if event host school and organizer was notified in writing and meat was not purchased.
- NO FIRES OR CHARCOAL CHIMMNEY'S ON THE GROUND at events. (Will be disqualified and could be liable for any damages).
- ALL TEAMS must signs new Sportsmanship Agreement and Event Waiver. Copies must be provided at first event to participate in any event.
- No Commercial filming or media without Host School District and National High School BBQ Association written approval and permission.
- NO DEEP FRYING AT ALL. That means no oil in a pan over 1/2 inch in volume. Any pan frying must be done on a burner and NOT open flame fire or barbecue pit, charcoal fire, or smoker.

(NOTE: These are highlights and each teacher, mentor, student, and coach is responsible for logging into SportsYou and going to their State HSBBQ folder for all current updates, documents, and information regarding this 2023-2024 HSBBQ League season for their STATE HSBBQ ASSOCIATION.)
